Outpatient hemodialysis is available for individuals in the community who require dialysis while residing at home or a local facility. This significant milestone represents a new era of enhanced care and expanded services for our residents and the local community.

Construction and Renovations

We are thrilled to share the successful conclusion of our extensive construction and renovation project, which involved substantial investments and enhancements throughout the facility. 
